









BOND REFERENDUM



Harlandale ISD partnered with Possip to understand community sentiment in advance of their 2022 bond. All three propositions of the Harlandale bond referendum passed.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE CHECKS

Seven schools across Metro Nashville Public Schools, including Antioch Middle School, partnered with Possip to complete required attendance assessments and help reduce the amount of truancy interventions needed.

Antioch was able to quickly learn about barriers to attendance from those families that would most benefit from intervention. Given the success of Possip Attendance checks last year, Antioch is preparing to re-start the program for the 22 - 23 school year.
