








Family Sentiment



Possip FAQs

Does Possip need to replace my annual survey?

• It doesn't need to - but it can if you want.

Depending on how you use customizable Bonus
Questions, you can gather the information
from your annual survey through Possip. In
reality, most Possip Partners use Pulse Checks
as a complement to their annual survey (which
Possip can also do for you). In an annual survey
(or Long Form Survey from Possip), you can
dive deeper and ask for feedback about several
topics. With Pulse Checks, you can get real
time information and course correct
throughout the year, and your families know
that they will receive invitations on a regular
schedule to share their praise or concerns.

Does this replace my outbound communication?

 No. In fact, we find a strong system of outbound communication is an important lever for strong community engagement. Pulse Checks allow you to measure general sentiment about your school campus(es) and solicit feedback about specific topics. Other tools like newsletters, text blasts, and apps are great ways to deliver information to families or staff.
 Possip is a tool in your communication toolbox that deepens the conversation by inviting responses, thoughts, and opinions from your community in the language they choose.

How long until I get the responses back?

Quickly! Within 3-5 business days you receive
an organized recommendation report that
highlights praise and categorizes needs,
concerns, ideas, and questions into hot, medium,
and cool categories to help you follow up. This is
unique - as most survey platforms require weeks
- and lots of people hours - to administer. Possip
is quick - and simple administratively. You get to
focus on what you do best - celebrating the good
and problem solving.

How do schools pay for Possip?

- Districts and schools find it manageable to pay for Possip using existing means. Depending on what type of feedback they plan to use, districts and schools pay for Possip in several ways including funds from Title I: ESSA, Parent Involvement; Title II Professional Development; Title III ELL; Title V: Innovative Programs; and PTO funds, grants, and discretionary funds.
- Many districts and schools see Possip tied to student recruitment and/or staff retention budgets. If Possip helps you keep just 1 student in a school - or 1 staff member in a building, it has paid for itself at least 3 times over.
